## 4th Annual Historic Preservation Awards

Spokane Preservation Advocates (SPA) hosts the Annual Historic Preservation Awards ceremony to celebrate those individuals and/or organizations who have contributed significantly to the preservation of Spokane/Spokane County's cultural heritage.

**The 2017 Awards Event is Sunday, Nov. 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.**

**Nomination Deadline: September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2017**

Awards are given in the following categories:

**Historic Preservation Education & Outreach Award:** given to a person or group who has dedicated efforts to educate and inform with regards to historic preservation.

**Preservation Media Award:** given to a person or group who has completed efforts to educate the public on preservation through websites, interpretive signage, books, smartphone apps, exhibits, or articles.

**Restoration & Preservation Project Award:** given for an outstanding restoration of historic building, structure and/or site.

**Rehabilitation Project Award:** given for an outstanding rehabilitation of an historic building, structure and/or site.

**Homeowner Preservation Award:** for homeowners who have dedicated considerable time, energy, and resources to restore their historic home.

**Green/Sustainable Preservation Award:** given to owners of completed projects that successfully take a sustainable approach to preserving historic places.

**Advocacy Award – Historic Buildings:** this award honors individuals who have demonstrated dedication, perseverance advocating for historic preservation in our area.

**Stewardship Award – Historic Buildings – Historic Landscapes:** for the exemplary long-term preservation of one or more of Spokane's or Spokane County's historic buildings or landscapes.

**Rural Restoration Award:** this award honors restoration and renovation of historic barns, homes and farmsteads within Spokane County.

**Adaptive Reuse Award:** for the re-purposing of a building or facility designed for a specific use and restored for a new and different use.

**Corporate Stewardship Award:** for the exemplary long-term preservation of corporate properties.

*The Award winners in each category will be honored at the ground floor of the Montvale Event Center at 1017 W. 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. on Sunday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017, at 6:00pm. Admission is free.*
